

HISTORY OF CAMP

When Covenant Cedars Bible Camp began its ministry in 1949, the Lord obviously had amazing plans for its future. Almost 70 years later, the camp facility now serves over 8,000 guests annually, hosts groups year-round, and has added a 9-month discipleship program for post high school students that want to invest in a year of personal growth. With a year-round fulltime staff of eight, plus three part-time staff and around thirty-five summer staff, the camp has become a center of ministry available to many Midwest churches. As many have said, Covenant Cedars is an oasis in the midst of the corn fields of Nebraska that God has "set aside" for His purposes of touching lives. Over 100 campers each summer proclaim a first-time relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ and many others experience a call to ministry in their lives.

Covenant Cedars is a place where relationships are formed and valued, and the Word of God is consistently taught. Our facilities are being upgraded every year; recently we've added several new cabins and meeting spaces. Our staff are trained to help protect every camper during their stay and provide whatever is needed to make that stay safe and comfortable. Our desire and mission is to provide an atmosphere where those who are not yet believers are introduced to Jesus Christ and those who are believers will grow in that relationship while here. The goal of our long-range facility plan is to assure that future generations will have a modern facility to use to further the Gospel message in our culture. 


SUMMER CAMP

RESONATE

Resonate Discipleship Experience is a nine-month discipleship journey that helps students discover their role in God's kingdom, deepen their understanding of scripture, and develop Godly character through Bible seminars, community life, service together, and mission trips. Resonate aims to help high school graduates and young adults gain clarity, confidence, and character that they might grow deeper in their relationship with Jesus and equip them to go further in the mission to which God is calling them. Across the nation, many students are abandoning their faith and the Church as they leave their youth groups and homes in pursuit of their adult identity. Resonate exists to provide a sacred space where students might instead be challenged to know their faith as their own and to learn how they may live out Christ-centered lives. HIRING FOR SUMMER OF 2018

Covenant Cedars Bible Camp is now hiring Summer staff for 2018. The summer staff experience at CCBC is a summer of serving God by serving our guests. Summer starts in May with staff training and ends the first week in August. Summer staff serve in a variety of roles from washing dishes to leading games. We are currently accepting applications for the following positions: lifeguard, tower facilitator, housekeeping, maintenance, kitchen worker, and program team member.
