We were blessed by a message to camp leaders by Dr. Peter Reid, Torchbearers International, as he proclaimed and reminded us, "What is over our heads is under His feet."

As camp leaders, we often tend to feel overwhelmed by the tasks in front of us. Dr. Reid reminded us that the most important thing we have to offer to our position is our walk with Jesus. That means that occasionally we must remove ourselves from the crowd and remain available to the Father 24/7.
